A guitar ragtime tune originally recorded by Maybelle Carter. Mother Maybelle Carter told the New Lost City Ramblers she learned it from a guitar player at an Old Dominion Barn Dance in Richmond, Virginia in the early 1950's.

A very similar, though more complex, version of the tune to the one tabbed here was originally played by John James in the late 1960's and was released on the Matchbox record label under the name of "Maybelle Rag". Its true name of "Victory Rag" was applied to later recordings such as "John James In Concert" on the Kicking Mule label (vinyl) and later by Stefan Grossman's Guitar Workshop on CD (sggw146).

The version tabbed here was originally transcribed from John James' playing by Kieran Fish back in 1980 but sadly the transcription was lost and could not be found (amazingly I seemed to have had the only copy and that had gone too). Consequently, I (Steve McWilliam) re-transcribed it based on what I could remember of Kieran's transcription and then added my own thoughts on the subject. As a result it does not completely match John's versions and, in fact, departs greatly from it, but it shouldn't be too far off and should at least be a reasonable version to play. Enjoy.
